

Launch+

An after-hours program for the STEM Launch community

Tuesdays & Thursdays, 3:30-5:30 p.m.

Open to 4th – 8th graders

No sessions on the first Thursday of every month.

What is it?

Structured, quiet work time in the library supervised by volunteer STEM Launch teachers. An administrator is on-site for each session.

An opportunity to complete homework or research, receive tutoring in any subject, collaborate on a PBL, and use technology for academic purposes.

What do I bring?

Bring all materials needed for your homework or PBL collaboration. Locker visits are not allowed.

Bring your student ID.

Leave valuables, music, and other distractions at home.

May I use a computer?

Yes! The library computers may be used only for *academic* purposes.

Technology options include IXL, Kahn Academy, Reading Plus, Think Through Math, and keyboarding practice.

Social networking and gaming are not allowed.

Signup is required!

Sign up in the main office. The supervising teacher will take attendance.

A signed Launch+ permission slip *must* be on file in the main office.

For safety purposes, parents must sign the student out upon pickup. Students may leave at any time, but cannot leave and return to the session. Students will not be allowed to walk home.
